**Streets and Traffic Safety 24.6%**

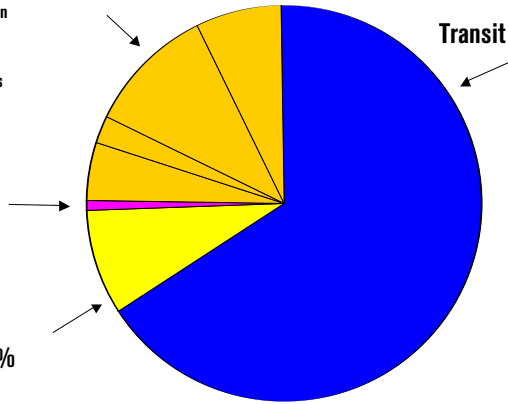

### Expenditure Plan by Type

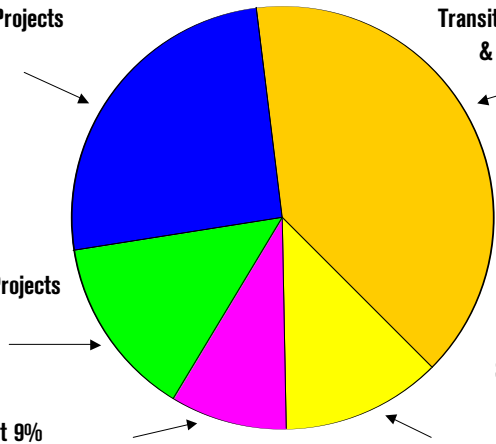

## INSIDE THE PLAN...

### Major Capital Projects

- Citywide network of fast, reliable bus and rail transit
- Build the Central Subway from SOMA to Chinatown
- Extend Caltrain downtown to a Rebuilt Transbay Terminal
- Rebuild the South Access to the Golden Gate Bridge (Doyle Drive)

### Projects and Programs

- Transit: Investments to improve and expand transit service, replace transit vehicles and maintain transit infrastructure and facilities.
- Paratransit: Support for door-to-door van and taxi services for seniors and people with disabilities who are unable to use fixed route transit.
- Streets and Traffic Safety: Funding for street resurfacing, maintenance equipment; traffic signs and signals; pedestrian and bicycle safety projects; traffic calming measures; and tree planting and maintenance.
- Transportation System Management / Strategic Initiatives: Support for neighborhood planning and parking studies, funds to increase land use/transportation coordination.
